The Transition Options Program (TOPS) addresses the unique needs of adults with Asperger's Syndrome or related disorders transitioning to higher education and/or employment. It is also open to those who have recently started college or work and need additional support. The program provides a structured and supportive environment for students to develop social skills, increase independence, develop interests, explore resources, participate in the community, and create a social network of support. This program is designed for adults ages 18 and above who have a primary diagnosis of Asperger's Syndrome, have exited the K-12 school system, and have a high school diploma. Students must meet all other entrance criteria. Participants do not need to be a Regional Center Consumer and do not need to live within the district boundaries to be eligible for application. Pre-registration and enrollment application required.
