Assessments information:

- Allow two hours for the assessment process; two-and-a-half hours if you need a typing speed assessment.
- 30 multiple choice reading comprehension questions.
- 32 multiple choice math competency questions using the basic operations which include fractions, decimals, percents, measurements (including complex area problems), graphs, charts, and critical thinking. No calculators allowed.
- Typing speed assessment is administered immediately after the math assessment.
