Job Announcement

P/T Teacher – Program for Adults with Asperger’s Syndrome

Description

Mt. Diablo Adult Education is seeking a qualified part-time teacher for a new program assisting adults with Asperger's Syndrome and related disorders in their transition to higher education and/or employment. Responsibilities include conducting new student intakes; communicating with caregivers; lesson planning; writing student goals and progress notes; supervising instructional assistants; and instructing in the areas of social/behavioral development, independent living skills, work/college readiness, and community resources.

Schedule

Tuesday-Friday, 12:30-3:30 (teaching hours), plus 3 hours per week for intakes, program development and communications (15 hours per week total).

The program operates on a school calendar, observing district holidays and breaks (may include summer hours).

Start Date: Non-teaching hours for intake to begin as soon as possible after August 18, 2008 (4-8 hours/week). Regular schedule begins Sept. 22, 2008 (program start date).

Qualifications

Applicants must have teaching experience with persons with disabilities, and possess or be eligible for an appropriate teaching credential. *(If not in possession of an appropriate credential, eligibility for an adult education credential includes verification of at least five years of related experience and/or education in the field).* Experience working with adults with Asperger’s, high-functioning Autism, or related disorders highly preferred.
